This new 42-storey office tower is strategically located between Melbourne’s CBD and the Docklands precinct and within walking distance to the Southern Cross Station.

Having been fully leased to the Minister for Finance – State of Victoria, it is the new headquarters for the Victoria Police. Spread across 65,000 square metres, it houses frontline police and investigators in transit and public safety, police safety, road policing and family violence. It also houses state emergencies and security, crime, counter terrorism and intelligence and covert support command.

This was a complete “Turn-key” solution project where MyModular provided a combination of: WireByClick 5Pin modular lighting looms; Mlex 3pin modular power leads and Mlex Feeds, back to prewired distribution boards as the fitting of accessories such as GPO’s. This provided a cost saving and time efficient solution for the customer. Project scope included 31 office floors, with more than 100,000 MyModular products used.
